IMPORTANT: The vaccination is voluntary and free of charge!

1. Approved vaccines in Germany

Vaccine	Information
BionTech	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vaccine type: mRNA vaccine • Vaccination recommendation: approved from 12 years of age • Vaccination schedule: two doses currently 4 weeks apart
Moderna	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vaccine type: mRNA vaccine • Vaccination recommendation: approved from 18 years of age • Vaccination schedule: two doses currently 4 weeks apart
Astrazeneca	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vaccine type: viral vector vaccine • Vaccination recommendation: Persons over 60 years of age <u>and</u> persons between 18 and 59 years of age after prior medical consultation and a personal risk assessment • Vaccination schedule: currently heterogeneous vaccination, i.e. the first vaccination is given with Astrazeneca and the second vaccination is given after 4 weeks at the earliest with an mRNA vaccine
Johnson & Johnson	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vaccine type: viral vector vaccine • Vaccination recommendation: Persons over 60 years of age <u>and</u> persons between 18 and 59 years of age after prior medical consultation and personal risk assessment • Vaccination schedule: one dose

2. Required documents

1.	Identity card or passport

3.	Consent form incl. medical history for coronavirus vaccination (2x) ➤ available in different languages at: https://www.zusammengegencorona.de/downloads/?filter=alldownloads&sort=date
4.	Only when booking an appointment via the Kassenärztliche Vereinigung: Appointment confirmation
5.	If available: medical documents such as medication schedule or allergy passport
A health insurance card is <u>not</u> required.	

3. Vaccination procedure

Procedure	Explanation
Registration	The data for the vaccination will be recorded on the basis of the documents that you have brought with you.
Medical consultation	You will be given an information leaflet and the consent form for the coronavirus vaccination if you have not already completed the paperwork at home.
Consultation with a doctor	You will have the opportunity to ask a doctor questions about the coronavirus vaccination and any side effects.
Vaccination	The vaccination is carried out by trained specialists.
Follow-up	Short stay (maximum 30 min) for precaution under medical observation.
