What is Griffbereit?



Griffbereit is a multilingual playgroup. This free service is directed towards parents with and without an immigration background who have children between the ages of one and three.

The children play, sing and paint together in the group and with their parents in the familial language and German. This lays the first foundations for language development.

Parents also learn how they can strengthen and support their children in the stages of early childhood development.

How does Griffbereit work?

In **Griffbereit**, parents and children come together each week for around an hour. The **Griffbereit** groups are led by trained parental support personnel.

In both the playgroup and the free play time and the common breakfast, parents receive a lot of information on the development and encouragement of their children. In addition, parents are presented with ideas and suggestions for play and language, which they can then also implement at home with their children.

But **Griffbereit** also offers parents the possibility to meet and talk with others with children in the same age groups. And the children, too, develop the first relationships with their peers.

The playgroup situation prepares the children for the transition to child day-care facilities.

What is special about Griffbereit?



In **Griffbereit**, all games, songs and activities are undertaken in both German and the familial language. This means that toddlers from families with and without immigration backgrounds come into contact with other languages from a very early age.
